Membership Fees

An annual dojo membership fee of \$75 adult/\$35 child (12 and under) is due when joining any regular dojo program and is due each January thereafter. Membership is required to attend any regular training session in any program, to test for rank promotion, receive regular private instruction, and to participate in dojo elections and voting.

Tuition Policies

Regular class registration in Tsubomi Dojo programs is required to participate in classes. Fees are determined by the venue, not by Tsubomi Dojo. Fees are non-refundable unless withdrawing before the first class. To be a member in good standing of Tsubomi Dojo, regular class registration must be maintained throughout the year, regardless of the payment of annual dues. If you are unable to attend classes for an extended period of time due to an unforeseen circumstance you may request a sabbatical; however, the decision to maintain membership and eligibility for rank promotion, private instruction, and participation in Tsubomi Dojo special events will be made at the discretion of the dojo treasurer and assessed on a case-by-case basis. Membership fees are used to maintain our practice spaces, invite guest instructors, support club activities, purchase club equipment and materials, provide a small stipend for our chief instructor, and to support the non-profit Pacific Northwest Budo Association in its efforts to educate the public about the benefits of Japanese martial and cultural arts practice.
